

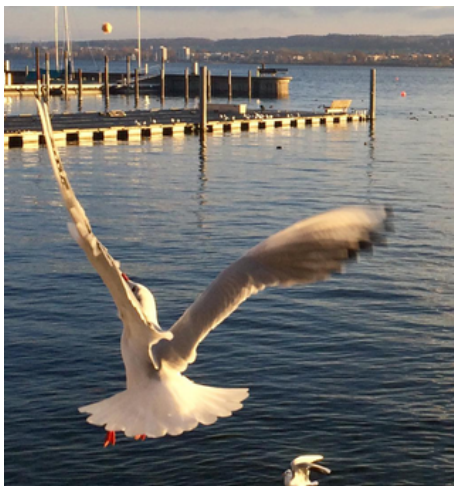


Dear friends,

also collecting and perhaps burying a seed here and there before winter spreads its hoarfrost magic.

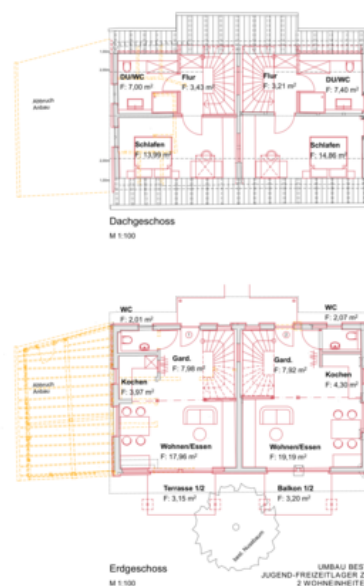


Messengers of joy brought us the building permit. Even the Stettener Newspaper benevolently formulated it: “Bodenseeheim is being rebuilt”.
